- Commitment understanding:
 - Time: 1 practice/game per week on Saturday mornings
 - Season: Starts end of April, beginning of May for 8 weeks
 - Location: Fremont Memorial Fields and/or Ellis School

Farm League

- Players 6 and 7 years old as of April 30th, 2017
- Commitment understanding:
 - Time: 1-2 practices/games per week, could be on any day, dependent on schedule and field availability
 - Season: Practices starting in April, season concluding by the end of June
 - Location: Fremont Memorial Fields and/or Ellis School and neighboring towns

Triple A League

- Players 8, 9 years old as of April 30th, 2017
- Commitment understanding:
 - Time: 2-4 practices/games per week, could be on any day, dependent on schedule and field availability
 - Season: Gym practices in March, season concluding by the end of June
 - Location: Fremont Memorial Fields and/or Ellis School and neighboring towns

Little League

- Players 10, 11 and 12 years old as of April 30th, 2017
- Commitment understanding:
 - Time: 2-4 practices/games per week, could be on any day, dependent on schedule and field availability
 - Season: Gym practices in March, season concluding by the end of June
 - Location: Fremont Memorial Fields and neighboring towns.

Babe Ruth (Played as part of Sanborn Babe Ruth with Kingston/Newton)

- Players 13, 14, 15 and 16 years old as of April 30th, 2017
- Commitment understanding:
 - Time: 2-4 practices/games per week, could be on any day, dependent on schedule and field availability
 - Season: Gym practices in March, season concluding by the end of June
 - Location: Kingston Fields and neighboring towns.

Softball

- Girls, 6 through 16 as of January 1st, 2017
- Commitment understanding:
 - Time: 2-4 practices/games per week, could be on any day, dependent on schedule and field availability
 - Season: Gym practices in March, season concluding by the end of June (10U and Older)
 - Location: Fremont Memorial Fields and/or Ellis School, and neighboring towns

Today's student athletes are in high demand. Players are overcommitted to many organizations and in doing so, fall short of performing at the levels that they can achieve. It is our goal, to coach the players to their fullest potential and in doing so, require their attendance at all practices and/or games. Excused absences are expected provided there is communication with the coach prior to the practice and/or game and the absences are not repeating.

Excessive, unexcused absences, from practices and/or games have a negative effect on the player and ultimately the team. This behavior may result in the player getting asked to forfeit their position on the team for a player that can fulfill the commitment.

Code Of Conduct

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The Purpose of the Fremont Athletic Association's Code of Conduct is to protect the children who participate in our programs and to teach the lessons of good sportsmanship. The Fremont Athletic Association has some of the most dedicated and helpful volunteers any organization could hope to have. We want to continue to support our coaches and positively encourage our players.

This document was prepared to outline the Association's expectations from it's participants, coaches and parents. When you register your child to participate in the Fremont Athletic Association programs, you agree to the code of conduct set forth in this document. In order to keep participation in FAA sports a rewarding experience for all those involved, failure to abide by the rules and guidelines in this document will be cause for disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to the following:

- _ Verbal warning by official, head coach, and/or director of the league. Ejection from the playing area.
- _ Written warning.
- _ Suspension for a minimum of one game, up to lifetime suspension from all FAA programs for parent, spectator, Coach, volunteer and/or participant. All violations will be kept on file by Fremont Athletic Association.
- _ Sanctioning action if necessary. FAA Board Members represent the organization and are considered officials at FAA events and have the right to enforce violations of the code of conduct. Disciplinary action will be determined by the Fremont Athletic Association's Board of Directors at their discretion. All decisions are final.

Players

- _ I will learn the rules of the sport and follow them to the best of my ability.
- _ I will respect my coach, be courteous, listen and perform to the best of my ability.
- _ I will respect my teammates and treat all other players the way I would like to be treated.
- _ I will respect my opponents.
- _ I will respect the officials and let them do their job.
- _ I will compete fairly and demonstrate good sportsmanship no matter if my team wins or not.
- _ I will only use social media in a positive manner.

Coaches

- _ I will be a positive role model for my team by learning and following the rules of the game/league, encouraging sportsmanlike conduct, showing respect, courtesy and positive support of the players, officials, other coaches and spectators at each game and practice.
- _ I will not engage in or encourage any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct.
- _ I will remember that children participate in sports to have fun and will work to organize practices that are fun and challenging to my players.
- _ I will treat each player as an individual and consider the large range of emotional and physical development for the age group.
- _ I will teach my players to respect the officials and I will respect the officials at all times.
- _ I will teach my team that doing one's best and working as a team, are the most important goals of youth sports.
- _ I will only use social media in a positive manner and encourage my players and parents to do the same.
- _ I will never physically, sexually or verbally abuse any player, coach, official or parent.
- _ I will never be under the influence of alcohol or drugs while participating in a WAA event.
- _ I will never use tobacco products at any FAA event.

Parents

- _ I will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials, parents and spectators at every game and practice.
- _ I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, parent or spectator.
- _ I will teach my child to play by the rules and follow the player's code of conduct.
- _ I will teach my child that doing one's best and working as a team is more important than winning.
- _ I will only use social media in a positive manner and encourage my child to do the same.
- _ I will inform the coach of any physical limitations that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
- _ I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during the games and practices, unless I am the team coach.
- _ I will demand a sports environment for my child and other children that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and will refrain from their use before and at all sports events.
